I was anointed with the oil of chrism so that God's power would make me strong to be like Him I was given a lighted candle to show that Christ was now present in my life




My parents and the Church community are now helping me prepare to celebrate Confirmation and Communion

At Mass...

We begin our prayers with the Sign of the Cross - In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

The priest welcomes us to the celebration.
